August 27, 2016**

- 1. Wichita First United Methodist Work Group**
 - Itinerary-The group of 16 will leave Wichita on September 15; work days are September 16 and 17; departure will be on September 18**

- Julie, Rosalie, Diane and Bruce will coordinate with Bonnie and Steve Laycock on organizing lodging and meals; sign-up sheets will be placed on the Fellowship Hall table for volunteers for food, beverages and work.
- Host Lodging Status:
 - Diane and Bruce: 5 people
 - Peter and Linda (Chase): 3 people
 - Doug: 4 people (two queen beds)
 - Julie and Rosalie: 1 person
 - Jean and Ken: 2 people (twin beds)
 - Church Nursery: 1-3 (cots & couch)
- Host families will provide breakfast on Friday, Saturday and Sunday
- Task List
 - The project list was refined and is attached – a variety of projects in case there are some that can't do heavy work
 - Doug will coordinate with Bonnie and Steve Laycock prior to their arrival on project tasks, tools and supplies
 - Material purchases
 - Cull lumber donation from Moore Lumber
 - Rosalie donated used lumber for projects; Mike Moore will pick up this Thursday
 - Some materials will be purchased prior to the groups arrival and the remaining will be secured from Moore Lumber once the group arrives
 - Wichita POC-Bonnie and Steve Laycock
 - We need DPUMC volunteer staff to work with the group similar as we did with the volunteers from Heritage United Methodist Church
 - Pre-work Day Meeting on September 10 in the Fellowship Hall to finalize task coordination, material purchase and lodging/food arrangements
- 2. Church Mortgage
 - Donna and Doug facilitated the two-year extension of payments on the mortgage with our noteholder; we have only been paying interest on the note
 - We will be making a recommendation to the Church Council to make a small payment on the principal
- 3. Insurance replacement values were established by Church Mutual (letters are in the Trustee Notebook)
 - No premium increase according to Donna
 - Doug Jenner supported the replacement values
- 4. Other
 - Doug will draft an "Official Thank You" letter for the group from Heritage United Methodist Church and present it for signature at the next Church Council meeting

- Electrical Projects
 - o Inspect and repair exterior outlets and lighting
 - o Run conduit on exterior to breaker panel for sign lighting and electric pedestal

- o Install permanent outlet for organ speakers
 - Plumbing
- o Install water hammer on cold line
- o Repair/install faucets in Fellowship Hall and Sanctuary Bathrooms
- o Repair/replace toilet tank in Fellowship Hall Bathroom
- o Install dishwasher in Fellowship Hall Kitchen
 - Carpentry
- o Inspect/rehang Sanctuary entrance double doors
- o Replace/repair handrail from church to Food Pantry
- o Inspect/repair gutters on Church (corners) and Parsonage repair
- o Repair fence in lower parking lot
- o Complete sanding and finishing on picnic tables
- o New sign post for "966" on upper parking lot entrance
- o Repair bear damage on trash storage bin
 - Exterior Steps
- o Form and pour concrete for 17 steps from lower parking lot to Church entrance
 - Install handrail on right side going up
- o Construct new steps from the upper parking lot to the Food Pantry
- o Repair platform to front deck of Parsonage
- o Form and pour concrete landing for ADA ramp to Fellowship Hall
 - Painting
- o Touchup areas where needed
- o Repaint large DPUMC sign
 - Landscaping
- o Move topsoil pile to fill in holes on the front grounds
- o Finish filling erosions ditches with rocks and material from snowplowing
- o Grade entrance to lower parking lot
- o Organize, purge and clean area under Parsonage front deck

Then all you have to do is sign in to their website, click on the store where you want to shop (amazon.com, Kohl's, Staples, Barnes & Noble among many

others), and make your purchases as usual. **The UMC Market app has updated so you have to go on their site and make a new account to continue to use it. People who already signed up for it should get an email letting them know they need a new account.**

The Food Pantry is in need of paper products, toilet paper, paper towels. Also feminine hygiene products are needed. Baking products, cake mixes, muffin, any small mixes. Also, juices in bottles; peanut butter, jelly, ramen noodle soup, macaroni and cheese, any gluten free items, also low or no sodium items. They also need empty egg cartons.
